Nicola Gökbuget is since 1990 member of the Department for Internal Medicine II, Hematology/Oncology of the University Hospital in Frankfurt. She is heading the Study Center of the Department and the Study Center of the Frankfurt Comprehensive Cancer Center (UCT).

For more than 20 years she serves as coordinator of the German Multicenter Study Group for Adult Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia (GMALL) with more than 140 participating hospitals all over Germany. She is coordinating or principal investigator of various academic or industry sponsored trials in adult ALL.

Nicola Gökbuget is founding member of the German Network for Acute and Chronic Leukaemia. Nicola Gökbuget is the head of the Information Center for Leukaemia. Furthermore, she is founding member of the European Leukemia Network which is funded in the 6th framework programme of the European Union. She is founding member and past chair of the European Working Group for Adult ALL (EWALL) and EHA Scientific Working group for ALL. Furthermore, she is Scientific Task Force Director at the University Cancer Center and Investigator at the German Consortium for Translational Cancer Research (DKTK) and the Frankfurt Cancer Institute (FCI).

Her scientific interest focuses on clinical research in the field of adult acute lymphoblastic leukemia including diagnosis, therapy, late effects, quality of life and evaluation of new drugs. Furthermore, she is involved in management, organization and logistical development of clinical studies in the field of leukemias and public health. She has published review articles, chapters for national and international textbooks and original articles on acute lymphoblastic leukemia on behalf of the GMALL study group and acted as invited speaker at various international meetings.
